Certified Nurse Aide (CNA) Licensure Disclosure

Upon completion of NRSG 106 Certified Nurse Aide (CNA), students who pass the CNA test approved by the state of Montana will obtain their CNA certificate and become eligible to work in long-term care facilities and other healthcare environments. Upon successfully passing the Montana Certified Nurse Aide exams, administered by D&S Diversified Technologies (Headmaster), the student must complete an online BOUNDS Montana CNA by Exam Application. Once processed, the student will be placed on the Montana Certified Nurse Aide Registry.
