Medical Laboratory Technology (MLT) Licensure Disclosure

Upon earning an <u>Associate of Applied Science in Medical Laboratory Technology</u>, graduates are eligible for the national examination for MLT by the <u>American Society for Clinical Pathology</u> (ASCP). After passing the national certification exam, graduates may apply for licensure in Montana.

- Be located in a state/territory for which FVCC's MLT program meets the educational requirements for licensure. Or,
