Surveying Licensure Disclosure

The <u>Associate of Applied Science in Surveying</u> meets the educational prerequisite requirements for licensing in Montana set by the <u>Montana Board of Professional Engineers and Professional Land Surveyors</u>. Upon earning the AAS in Surveying, graduates can take the Land Surveying Intern (LSI) exam. In Montana, an additional six years of experience under the supervision of a licensed surveyor is required before the actual licensing (LS) exam can be taken.

- Be in a state/territory for which FVCC's surveying program meets the educational requirements for licensure. Or,
- Sign an attestation acknowledging that they are in a state/territory where FVCC's surveying program does not meet (or has not determined if the program meets) the educational requirements for licensure but will be seeking licensure and employment in a specified state/territory for which FVCC's program meets the educational requirements for licensure.

This disclosure indicates the states and territories that FVCC has determined through a reasonable, good-faith effort that the surveying program **meets**, **does not meet**, or has **not determined** if the program meets the educational requirements for licensure. Other requirements include but are not limited to, application and licensing fees, state or professional exams, criminal background checks, obtaining a bachelor's or graduate degree, years of supervised experience, an NCEES Record Book, etc. Continuing education may also be required for the maintenance of licensure/certification.
