High School Equivalency Class & Testing Process for 17+-year-olds

Paperwork Requirements

17-year-olds

- High School or Homeschool Withdrawal Letter (*see below)
- Consent to Share School Withdrawal Documentation signed by a parent/guardian
- Consent to Release Personal Information form signed by a parent/guardian

18-year-olds

- High School or Homeschool Withdrawal Letter (*see below)

19+

No additional documentation needed prior to signup

***High School / Homeschool Withdrawal Letter Requirements**

- Letterhead, legal name and date of birth, last date of attendance, signed by chief education officer (CEO)
- Homeschool withdrawal letter template available upon request.

Program Requirements

Attend an **orientation** session that includes taking the TABE (reading and math assessments).

- FVCC: _____ starting @ 9am, ending around 1:00pm (on average)
- LCC: _____ starting @ 10am, ending around 2:00pm (on average)

Scholarship Eligibility

Enroll in and complete an Adult Education class.

- ****Regularly attend class (at least 40 hours of program participation)**
FVCC: _____ - _____, Monday – Thursday, 9am-12:30pm
LCC: morning and evening classes available. Speak with the instructor to schedule.
- ****Complete a TABE posttest and make an educational gain.**

Testing Fees

****Scholarship Requirements**

HiSET

- \$15 per subject test (\$75)
- schedule and pay online
- 3 tries per subject per year

GED

- \$26 per subject test (\$104)
- schedule and pay online
- 1 retake included in cost

FVCC Testing Center

- \$5.00 per subject test
- Paid to FVCC's Business Office day of testing
- Not included in Scholarship

Schedule Tests

Create an account with HiSET or GED online (hiset.org or ged.com). You will use this account to schedule and pay for your computer-based testing. Keep track of your username, password and ID#.

****NOTE:** All individuals looking to test must have a valid, government-issued photo ID that will be used for HSE testing check-in (Proof of Montana residency): State ID, Driver's License, Driver's Permit, Tribal ID**
