To be considered official, this letter must be on business letterhead or notarized.

4.	Work on Essential Education online and attend an HSE Prep Class, Monday – Thursday, 9am-12:30pm				
5.	. Prove preparedness on all GED or HiSET subjects through official Practice Tests				
6.	FVCC Scholarship: Complete 20+ program hours and reach "Pass" on EE's GED/HiSET Prep. ***Scholarship is only available for in-person testing fees.**				
7.	7. Adult Education staff will submit a Signed Instructor Recommendation and all paperwork to the Office of Public Instruction for approval. You will be notified once approved for testing, and we will assist in scheduling tests.
